As a general rule, one must focus on the keywords and phrases used in the question. One must also try to sense the overall tone of the question.

Q. Elucidate how mixed method approach addresses the concerns of reliability and validity in social research. (20)

Key words and phrases: 'elucidate', 'mixed method approach', 'concerns of reliability and validity in social research'

The language of the question indicates that the examiner is looking not only for clarity regarding the concepts of reliability and validity but also interested in knowing the practical challenges that a researcher may face in addressing the concerns of reliability and validity when the research is actually conducted. Since mixed method approach involves the use of both quantitative as well as qualitative methods of research, candidate must highlight the advantages and limitations of both before explaining that how mixed method approach addresses the concerns of reliability and validity.


